

## A Consistent Way to Contribute

### What is Bill Pay?

Bill Pay is a service provided by your financial institution that allows you to use online banking for anything that you would normally pay by check.

### Why contribute using Bill Pay?

- Bill Pay allows you to financially give more consistently and automatically.
- Bill Pay offers solutions to infrequent/inconsistent giving caused by:
  - non attendance (illness, travel, etc)
  - arriving late to worship services
  - forgetting to bring checkbook or cash
  - not budgeting your regular contribution
- Ultimately, Bill Pay allows you to prayerfully decide in your heart how you will worship through giving by intentionally setting up a method that truly provides an offering of your first fruits that will be consistently contributed until you intentionally remove this service.

### How to set up Bill Pay?

1. Enroll in bill pay through your bank (usually a free service).
  - a. TDECU

2. Add **Danbury Baptist Church** as a payee
3. Enter the mailing address of the church:

**Danbury Baptist Church**  
**P.O. Box 157**  
**Danbury, TX 77534**
4. Designate the amount and the frequency of payment.
  - a. You can enter a onetime amount and designate it as a reoccurring payment (recommended)
  - b. You can enter an amount each time you would like to send a contribution to the church.
5. Your bank mails a check to the church.
