

COVID-19 Updated Reopening Details

Due to elevated numbers of cases in Brazoria County and recent moves made by Gov. Abbott and the Strike Force to Open Texas, we are voluntarily returning to a combination of precautions from our prior reopening phases in an attempt to remain faithful and to provide as many essential services as possible:

1. **AT-RISK POPULATION**— We want to strongly encourage our at-risk population to remain home. For your convenience a recording of the sermon will be provided, giving is available online, and Sunday School curriculum is available upon request. At-risk population are those who are 65 or older, especially those with chronic lung disease; moderate to severe asthma; chronic heart disease; severe obesity; diabetes; chronic kidney disease undergoing dialysis; liver disease; or weakened immune system
2. **DESIGNATED AREA**— We are designating the Fellowship Hall, with its overflow capability, to host our at-risk population that will be in attendance. This section is reserved for at-risk attendees to be used at their discretion.
3. **PROPER SPACING**— Keep at least two empty seats (or six feet separation) between parties in any row, except as follows:
 - Two or more members of the same household can sit adjacent to one another, with two seats (or six feet separation) empty on either side.
 - Two individuals who are not members of the same household but who are attending together can sit adjacent to one another, with two seats (or six feet separation) empty on either side.
4. **PEWS**— In order to promote proper spacing, we are again alternating rows between attendees (every other pew left empty).

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION:

MASKS: We want everyone to feel as comfortable and safe as possible. Please wear a mask if that increases your comfort. Masks are not required.

NO CONTACT: This is the hardest thing to revisit, but please refrain from hugs, handshakes, and holy kisses. Please wave, smile, and wink at your friends and neighbors this week.

CHILDCARE: Please continue to pre-screen your children and sign your little ones into both nursery and children's church.

SIGNAGE: Signs regarding best hygiene practices and other pertinent information have been posted. The information on these signs do not necessarily express perfectly the thoughts of DBC or its leadership, but they are regarded as helpful informative guidelines.
